Since there are extra corner blocks, use them to form the second floor.

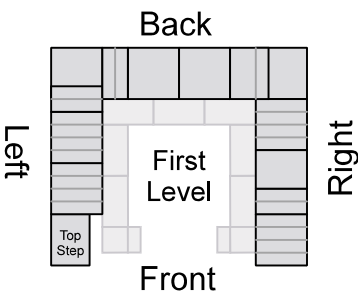


Decorative Braces



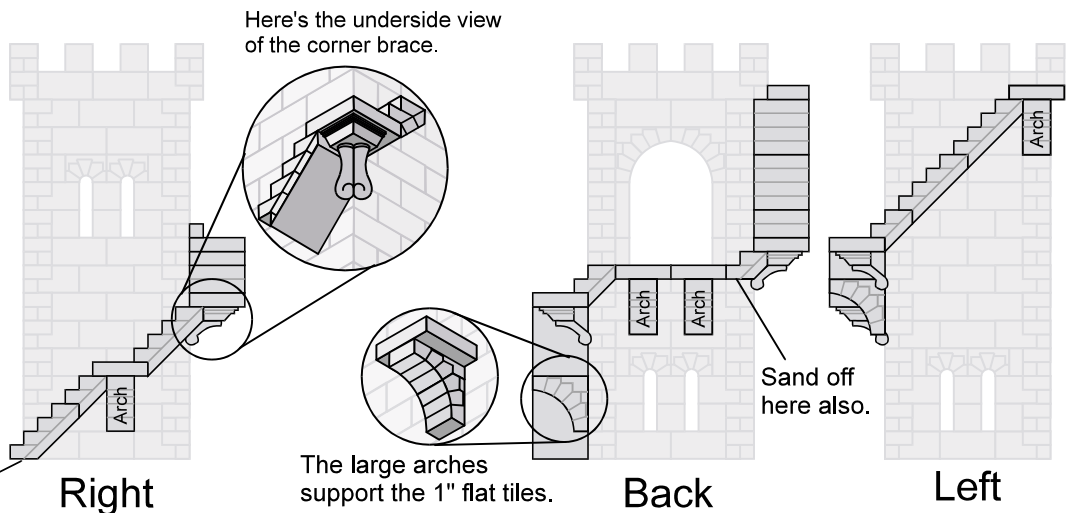
This sheet shows a brick-by-brick layout of the prison tower. Row 1 is the first row of blocks, all the way up to row 15 which are the top crenellations.

If you want to take this model apart in sections, mark where "not to glue" using a marker on the blocks. These marks will serve as a reminder for you later on (it's real easy to forget and end up gluing the whole thing together).



Here are the views of each of the stair pieces that go around the edge.

You will have to sand the sharp bottom off the first stair block.

The dark blocks are flat floor tiles. You will have to trim one down to 3/4" wide.
